Community Park Benches – I located a company who could provide recyclable slats for the exact benches we have. Total Cost to replace 28 sets is \$16,916.00 to be paid from capital monies set aside in an old ordinance for park seating.

Camp Dawson - Chain Link Fence – holes in the fence needing repairs. A gait should be considered in the middle to prevent people from jumping the fence which causes the damage. Loose safety nets need to be zip tied together again.
