Director's Update –The Rec. Cross Country League took 4 League Championship titles this year. Introduced player evaluations for all 5th – 8th grade Rec. Basketball players this year, over 300 kids attended. Practices will begin the end of November; games start 1/3/18-3/15/18. There was a great shortage of coaches throughout the entire boy's division this year. Registration for 3rd grade boys dropped tremendously from last year. Travel BB introduced travel at the 3rd grade level this year.

Punch List (Old Business)

Community Park Playground Replacement update –I designed a playground survey that is advertised on Google docs through 11/24. The survey was also distributed at the playground for 4 hours on 10/21, and to all families attending the Halloween Trick or Trunk. I worked with Ben Shafer and General Recreation's designers over the past month to revise their concept plans with suggested equipment to be reviewed by the Playground Committee at 6:30pm on 11/8. October Playground Status update report is attached. I met with both Jan & Troy Fence companies and two excavating companies in October to get estimates on fencing, demo and removal.

Community Park Turf replacement update – Turf installation and field lining is complete. Rubber infill still needs to be smoothed out, the warrantee and field groomer still need to be received. The field will be opening once all is complete and the Township Committee signs off. Soccer has received constant updates.

Masar Park Lighting update – Director is proposing a 30/20 HID light source sufficient for slow pitch softball use rather than 30/50. This will reduce the cost of materials significantly. The Musco estimate for Masar Park came in at \$189,000. Securing an additional quote from Qualite.

Eckhart Barn – Air Conditioning installation to be considered in spring of 2018. Capital monies are already in place.

Completed Projects/Punch List Items-

Community Park- The new picnic tables and benches for the Volleyball Court area and bench slats for the playground area have been received and will be put together as DPW has the time to do so.
