### Land Use and Zoning Department Brian Alfonso, Planning Aide

The Zoning Department wants to remind residents it is required by the township's ordinance that homeowners in our community must be diligent removing any dead/diseased trees on their property. Montville Township is particularly comprised of mass forestry, which is why it is important to not ignore this issue. Trees can be affected by several tree-killing diseases and insects that can weaken and disease trees, becoming a dangerous hazard. This time of year, it is crucial to help minimize the amount of dead and disease trees for the betterment of our community. Dead and diseased trees represent a significant danger to pedestrians walking or driving, buildings and power lines that are in the vicinity of these trees. Montville Township's ordinances, under code 287-18 Landscaping, states: "The landscaping of premises shall be maintained in an orderly state, with lawns and bushes trimmed and free from becoming overgrown, littered and unsightly where such would constitute a blighting effect, thereby depreciating adjoining and nearby property. Dead or dying trees or shrubbery shall be removed, and any dead or dying trees or shrubbery planted as part of site approval shall be replaced." The Zoning Department's purpose is to regulate and develop land use to ensure proper land use value and safety for the community.
