WHO: Grades 9 to 12

WHAT: An opportunity to ski or snowboard OR learn to ski or snowboard at a Pennsylvania ski area. Choices of packages are available from just purchasing lift tickets & transportation to purchasing lift tickets, lessons, rentals, & transportation. Note: This program is being offered as a package deal. Individual ski/snowboard trips are not available. Participant must purchase a total package of four trip dates. **JOIN US ON FRIDAY NIGHTS FOR SKIING, BOARDING, SOCIALIZING & FUN WITH FRIENDS & CLASSMATES!!!** ***** HELMETS are MANDATORY!!!** ***** New Helmet Rental Option! *****

OPTIONAL Discount Meal Plan for 4 trips: Choose # 1 burger + fries or # 2 chicken tenders + fries or # 3 pizza + baked cookie. Includes either (1) fountain drink or (1) bottled water. You pick each trip (non-refundable).

WHERE: Shawnee Mountain Ski Area - Shawnee-on-Delaware, Pa.

WHEN: Fridays: January 5, 19, 26 & February 2 (No: 1/12* unless needed)
 * *Make-ups because of inclement weather and/or conditions will be added on at the end!*
 Transportation will DEPART from the Community Park at **2:45pm**. Anticipated arrival back to the Community Park is **10:15pm**. Transportation is on a Motor Coach Bus with storage underneath. (SKI BOOTS **MUST BE** stored underneath the bus.)

TRANSPORTATION FEE will be PAID DIRECTLY to Montville Recreation FIRST.
ONCE PAID you will RECEIVE a LINK from Montville Recreation to COMPLETE your registration (after Oct 6th) AND PAY DIRECLTY through SHAWNEE MOUNTAIN for the specific PACKAGE you choose for your child/ren.

1. In Person at Rec Desk Kiosk during office hours of Monday through Friday:8:30am to 4:30pm.

(Check, Cash with No Fees and/or Credit Card with a 3% Fee)

2. On-Line from Home (Echeck with 1% Fee OR Credit Card with 3% Fee)

OR 3. Payment Drop Box in Municipal Building's Parking Lot (Check Only...must have family page set up on Community Pass)

AFTER we receive PAYMENT for TRANSPORTATION, we will send a LINK to COMPLETE and PAY your registration with SHAWNEE MOUNTAIN after OCTOBER 6th. This MUST BE COMPLETED by Wednesday, NOVEMBER 1st!

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. Rentals (equipment) can also be obtained on your own by contacting any local ski rental shop.
2. ***** HELMETS are MANDATORY!!! Also highly recommended are WRIST GUARDS for SNOWBOARDERS!**
3. If trips are canceled due to inclement weather, they will be added on later in the season. **REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GIVEN** for missed trips by the participants!!! **SUBSTITUTIONS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED!!!** Participant will receive (1) absentee voucher for only (1) missed trip. The voucher is good for the package purchased (Ex. twilight lift ticket, and/or rental).
4. Registration confirmation will be mailed prior to the first trip date outlining the rules and regulations. **Waivers MUST BE signed & returned ASAP.**
5. **NOTE PRICE CHANGE AS OF OCTOBER 18, 2023 !!!** Taken on a first-come/first-served basis. **SEATING IS LIMITED !!!**
6. **Once you've registered your child with Shawnee Mountain there are NO REFUNDS without a DOCTOR'S NOTE & there is a \$25.00 PROCESSING FEE! Pro-rated refunds are at the discretion of Shawnee Mountain and are for injury/medical reasons only and will not be issued AFTER the conclusion of the 2nd trip. Refunds up to and including \$100.00 will be issued in the form of a Shawnee Mountain GIFT CARD!!! No refunds for transportation!**

MONTVILLE RECREATION SKI CLUB POLICIES 2024

OUR PHILOSOPHY

The Recreation Department wants nothing more than for all of our ski participants and volunteer chaperones to enjoy the Ski Club trips we sponsor each year. Taking part in this or any of our sponsored programs is a privilege and we expect all our participants to respect our volunteer chaperones, all participants, the buses along with drivers, and ski facility we utilize for our trips.

We have put a formal Ski Trip behavior policy together, so that all are very clear of the expectations all will be held accountable for in advance of registering for the program. Parents are expected to review these items with their child/ren and required to sign off on the policies below.

BEHAVIOR POLICY

The Recreation Department has a zero tolerance for bullying, fighting, abusive language, disrespecting chaperones, other participants, or their property, smoking or vaping on the bus or anytime during the trip, and/or disrespecting the bus or lodge property in any way. Non-adherence to any of the above policies may result in the immediate removal from the program, which may require a parent/guardian to pick up their child at the ski lodge if necessary. This may also result in permanent removal from the ski program without a refund.

BUS TRANSPORTATION POLICY

Students must arrive promptly for the bus departure times. There are four ski trips, please make the necessary arrangements to ensure you are there waiting in the lot to pick up your child on the return of the trip. Our Chaperones are not permitted to release any participants into a car service such as Uber, Lyft, etc. They will only release participants to their parents or designated drivers if a note is provided to the chaperones the night of a trip. Parents should arrive at least TEN MINUTES BEFORE the bus is expected to arrive back from the lodge. OUR VOLUNTEER CHAPERONES SHOULD NEVER HAVE TO WAIT FOR LATE ARRIVING PARENTS! Late arrivals for pick up may result in the loss of bus privileges without a refund.

There is absolutely no standing on the bus while the bus is in motion. Students should use the restroom at the Youth Center before the trip or must wait to use the bus bathroom when the bus is stopped or reached the lodge. The throwing of objects, littering, smoking, vaping, playing of music through a speaker and/or phone, or loud noises that distract the driver will result in a warning and/or the immediate removal from the ski club program without a refund.

CHAPERONE RESPONSIBILITIES

Chaperones report directly to the Recreation Supervisor. They are responsible for the general oversight of the participants in the ski program, ensuring all safety and behavior policies are being followed, and reporting any accident/incident, injuries, or concerns to our Recreation Supervisor immediately.

Chase Car responsibility includes the above when at the lodge and responsible, if necessary, for following an ambulance to the hospital and waiting with the child until a parent arrives.

Parents will have the opportunity to volunteer to be a chaperone later.

CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR VOLUNTEERING CHAPERONES

Must complete a fingerprint background check directly through the Recreation Department (required every three years thereafter). Fingerprinting must be done directly through the Recreation Dept. regardless of what your profession and/or how recently you had them done for another purpose, i.e., firearms permit, etc.

Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19 for Participant

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. It is reported to be extremely contagious, with no known treatments, cure or vaccine. COVID-19 is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact, however the exact methods of spread and contractions are still unknown. People reportedly can be infected and show no symptoms and therefore spread the disease. Evidence has shown that COVID-19 can cause serious and potentially life threatening illness and even death.

Montville Township Recreation has put in place preventative measures that abide by the New Jersey State Department of Health Guidelines to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however Montville Township Recreation cannot prevent you or your child from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while participating in recreation sponsored programs or events. It is not possible to prevent against the presence of the disease. Therefore, if you or your child choose to participate in any programs or events you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I have read and understood the above warning concerning COVID-19. I hereby choose to accept the risk of contracting COVID-19 for myself and/or my child in order to participate in a recreation sponsored program or event. These services are of such value to me and my child that I accept the risk of being exposed to, contracting, and/or spreading COVID-19 in order to participate in programs or events sponsored by the Montville Township Recreation Department.

WAIVER OF LAWSUIT/LIABILITY: I hereby forever release and waive my right to bring suit against the Township of Montville, its departments, agencies, boards, commissions, officers, officials, agents, servants, administrators, and employees, or other representatives in connection with exposure, infection, and/or spread of COVID-19 related to (as a result of participating in a recreation sponsored program/event). I understand that this waiver means I give up my right to bring any claims including for personal injuries, death, disease or property losses, or any other loss, including but not limited to claims of negligence and give up any claim I may have to seek damages, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen.

CHOICE OF LAW: I understand and agree that the law of the State of New Jersey will apply to this contract.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ALL PROVISIONS OF THIS RELEASE, AND FREELY AND KNOWINGLY ASSUME THE RISK AND WAIVE MY RIGHTS CONCERNING LIABILITY AS DESCRIBED ABOVE.
