CONTRACTOR SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 1. Prior to obtaining a permit for road openings in the Township of Montville, the contractor must comply with the following:
 - a). Submit plot or site plan of work site.
 - b). Depict locations of traffic control devices (refer to Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices), current edition.
 - c). Describe what type of devices will be utilized on work site (all of which must conform to M.U.T.C.D.), current edition.
 - d). All devices must be positioned in accordance with M.U.T.C.D., current edition.
- 2. Construction work will only be permitted during time specified on application.
 - a). Emergency situations, or work required beyond the permitted time must be approved by the Traffic Bureau.
- 3. Streets closed to all traffic must be closed and opened at times specified on application.
- 4. Traffic lanes closed to traffic must be closed and opened at times specified on application.
- 5. Construction equipment is not to be positioned on any street after hours unless approved by the Traffic Bureau.
- 6. When a contractor is requested to supply uniformed police officers, arrangements shall be made through the Traffic Bureau and the officers will be assigned by the Chief of Police.
- 7. Flagmen Regulations:
 - a). Flagmen, when utilized in construction work areas, shall be equipped with the following:
 - (1). Orange Vest
 - ii). Orange cap may be used in lieu of vest.
 - iii). During warm weather, orange tee shirt may be used in lieu of vest.

NOTE: For nighttime conditions similar outside garments shall be reflectorized.

- (2). Red Flag 24" X 24"
 - i). For nighttime conditions lights shall be used in lieu of flag.

CONTRACTOR SAFETY REGULATIONS CONT'D.

- (3). Sign paddles consisting of STOP/SLOW messages as per M.U.T.C.D. specifications.
 - i). When used at night the STOP and SLOW faces shall be reflectorized.
- 8. Private Guard Regulations

Signature of Applicant

- a. When private guards are to be utilized in construction areas, the requirements as prescribed under flagmen regulations shall not apply provided that the private guard is attired in a uniform.
- b. The only exception is that of nighttime conditions, whereby the use of lights and reflectorized outer garments shall be required.
- 9. Lighting in construction areas shall be utilized from sunset to sunrise.
- 10. Contractor must list on the application form the names of at least two persons responsible for responding to emergency repairs after hours.
- 11. Chapter 330, Article II, Section 330-20 of the code of the Township of Montville requires that a permit be issued prior to commencing with any construction. Chapter 330 requires that:
 - a. Excavations must be properly barricaded, and during hours of darkness proper warning lights shall be provided.
 - b. Street closing is not permitted unless approved by the Chief of Police.
- 12. Prior to commencing with construction, the work site must be inspected by a Traffic Safety Officer for compliance.
- 13. Prior to issuance of Permit, Applicant must notify NJ ONE CALL MARKOUT by calling 1-800-272-1000 or Fax (908) 232-9570.
