Transportation Options in Morris County

Train

NJ Transit has two main railways that run through Morris County. They are the Montclair-Boonton Line and the Morris-Essex Line, with many stops throughout Morris County. For more information and schedules, please contact NJ Transit at 973-275-5555 or [www.njtransit.com](http://www.njtransit.com).

Bus

NJ Transit has 8 bus routes in Morris County. In addition to the numerous bus stops along these routes, the buses also stop at the Morristown Train Station and the Dover Train Station. Access Link

The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requires that public transportation systems provide ADA paratransit service to individuals who are unable to use local bus service as a result of their disability. Access Link is the NJ Transit public transportation that complies with the ADA regulations. Access Link is available during the same service days/hours as the scheduled fixed route bus service up to  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile off the route. MAPS

The Morris Area Paratransit System provides curb to curb transportation to residents who are senior citizens; people aged 18 or older with a physical or mental disability with functional limitations; or those who reside in rural areas of the county.

Trips to medical appointments have a high priority. Trips to work, school and adult day care are also important. If scheduling permits, transportation for other reasons, like nursing home visits, may be available.
