On 4/24/2022, Montville Township Police Officers Michael Palma and Sam Greendyk responded to a residence for a medical call. At the scene, Officers Palma and Greendyk utilized the AED defibrillator and performed CPR. The Montville Township Police Department is proud to report as a result of our Police Officers' efforts, the individual was resuscitated and survived.

Earlier this year, Det. Scott McGowan, Montville Township PD's School Resource Officer, participated as a panelist at a school safety symposium held at the ESCNJ Professional Conference Center in Piscataway. The Middlesex County Prosecutor asked him to be part of the panel. The symposium was geared for law enforcement administrators and educators.

The Montville Township Police Department would also like to remind residents that auto theft has been on the rise throughout the State. Remember to lock your cars and remove your keys and key fobs. Through these efforts we can all help reduce the crime of auto theft.



Ban on Single-Use Paper and Plastic Bags in NJ starts on May 4, 2022!

We are reminding businesses and consumers that starting May 4, 2022, NJ retail stores, grocery stores and food service businesses may not provide or sell single-use plastic carryout bags and polystyrene foam food service products. Single-use paper carryout bags are allowed to be provided or sold, except by grocery stores equal to or larger than 2500 sq. ft., which may only provide or sell reusable carryout bags.

The 2022 Primary Election is right around the corner! Early voting will take place June 3rd through June 5th at one of the established EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS in Morris County (check the Morris County Board of Elections for a list of locations). Primary Election Day in Montville is June 7th. Polls will be open from 6am until 8pm. Voter registration deadline for the Primary is May 17th. If you would like to receive a mail-in ballot for just one election or all future elections, you can complete an application. Mail it to the County Board of Elections by the May 31st mailing deadline. If you miss that deadline, you can bring it to the Morris County Clerk's Office (in Morristown) by June 6th at 3pm. Montville Township is responsible for 115 centerline miles of roads, so there is no doubt that our Public Works Department has their hands full every winter event. Our crew plowed and salted 12 winter storms in 2022. True to NJ weather, these storms involved a mix of snow, ice, AND slush. Special thanks to our team for their tireless work managing these storms in order to keep our roads safe for our residents. This often involves our crews working for 24 hours straight!

Spring is upon us which means our street sweeping program has also begun. Please be reminded you are NOT permitted to throw litter, bottles and/or grass clippings into the Township storm drains. Storm drains carry stormwater directly to our rivers and streams – help keep Montville and our rivers clean! Preparation for our 2022 road paving program is underway. Two road improvement projects have been awarded already and will begin this spring. Other road work will commence later this year.

Field preparation and maintenance for various sports are underway. Please assist our staff in disposing of your litter into a nearby receptacle, rather than leaving it on the fields.
