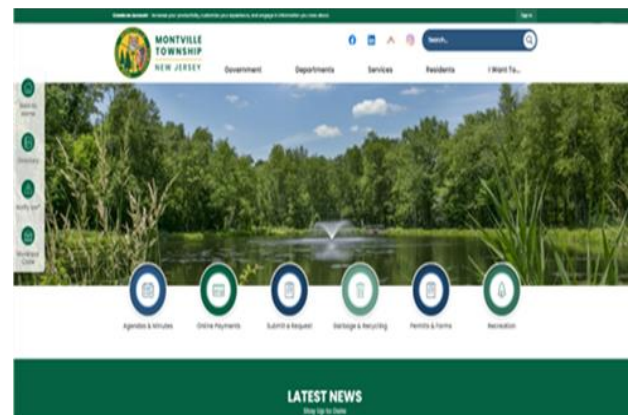

Montville Township enacted a Septic License to Operate (LTO) Ordinance (§ 430-15.1).

This ordinance requires property owners in Montville Township to obtain/maintain a permit to operate their septic system. The license is valid for a period of three years. LTO Licenses will be given to the homeowner after said pumping takes place by the Septic Pumper, who is licensed by the Township. To renew the permit after the initial three-year period, property owners must have their septic systems pumped.
